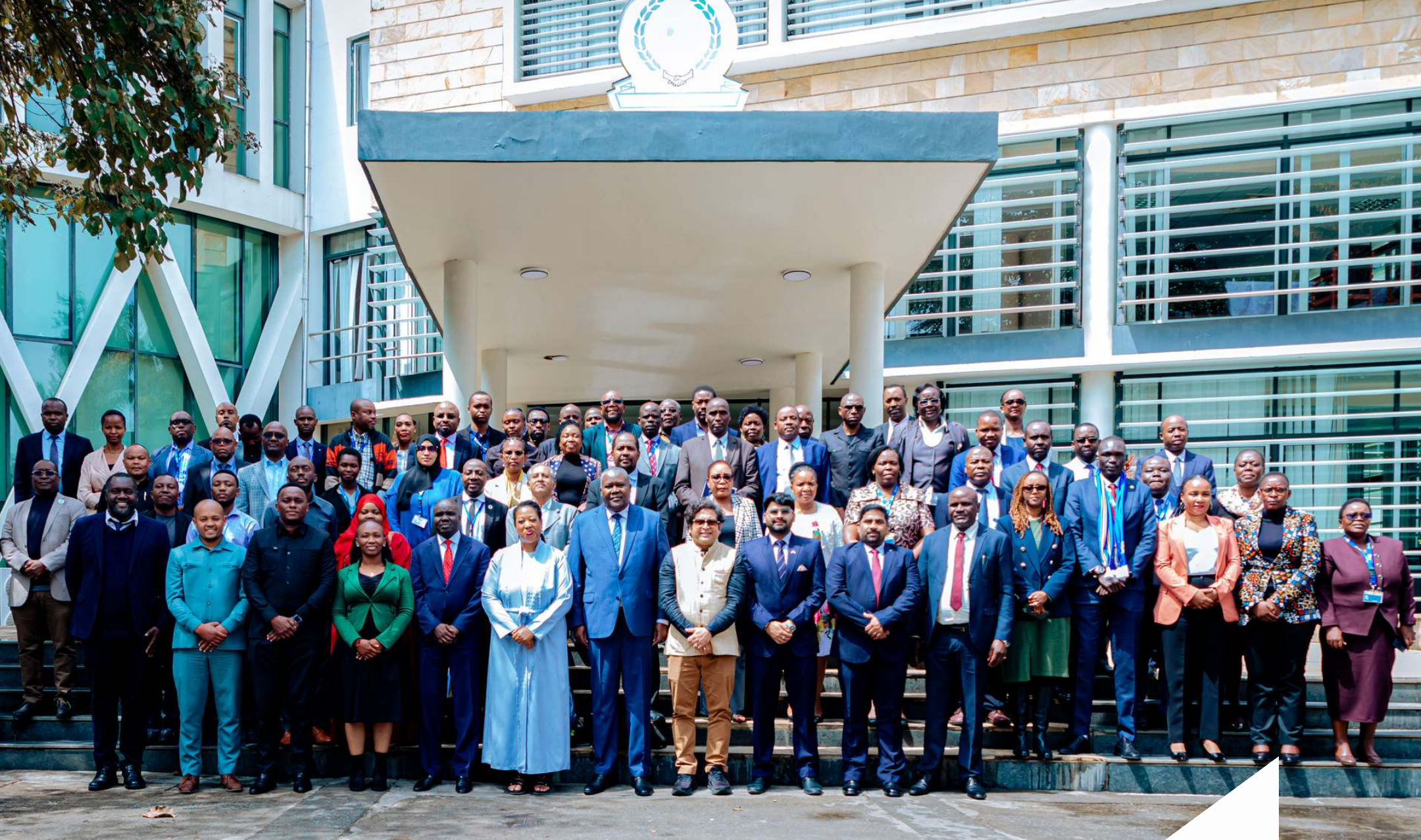

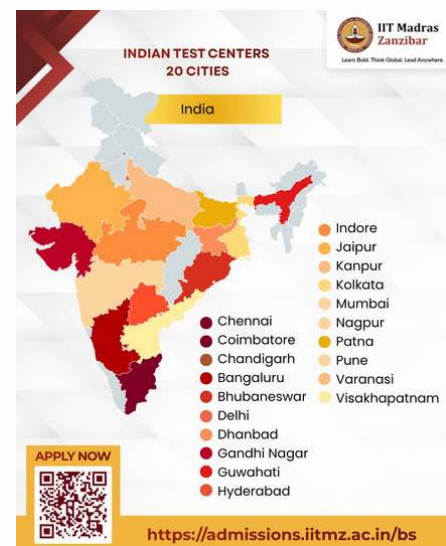

RESEARCH & ACADEMIC MILESTONES
